

## NEIGHBORHOOD BILL OF RIGHTS NOTIFICATION

You have received this NOTICE because you are the designated representative for a registered Association under the Neighborhood Bill of Rights Ordinance (No. 2007-1). Details regarding a St. Johns County project scheduled for your area have been provided below. Please be advised, umbrella associations are provided notice as a courtesy and do not share the same rights afforded to Neighborhood Associations as defined by the Neighborhood Bill of Rights Ordinance.

<u>Project Name</u>: Longleaf Pine Parkway -- FY2025 Roadway Improvements

**Project Location:** Greenbriar Road to CR210/CR16A Intersection.

<u>Project Description</u>: Mill 2.5 inches of existing roadway asphalt from edge of pavement to edge of pavement. Asphalt overlay will be a two-lift process consisting of a 1.5-inch structural course of SP12.5 asphalt and 1 inch fiction course of FC 9.5 asphalt. Pavement markings (where designated). Traffic control (MOT) prior to and during construction is established by signage and flaggers. Expect temporary single lane closures throughout the duration of the project.

Approximate Date of Commencement: June 9,2025

<u>Project Duration</u>: Approximately 20 days. Under some circumstances, extended or weekend hours may be necessary. Start date and hours are subject to change due to weather or other unforeseen conditions.

County staff is required to document all commitments or agreements made during such meetings.
